

How to use your MemberNet TV remote



Although there are multiple buttons on this remote there are only 4 active buttons to navigate your MemberNet TV Ultra Menu.


- 1. Power OFF/Restart
- 2. Back to Main Menu
- 3. Navigate Menu (Directional Pad)
- 4. Select

From time to time remotes may change due to availability but they all should function the same way.

Getting Started

- 1. Plug in Power Cable to MemberNet TV Ultra.
- 2. Connect HDMI Cable to MemberNet TV Ultra and HDTV or HDMI Distribution Amplifier.
- 3. Press Power Button on front of MemberNet TV Ultra Player. LED light turns on.



4. Upon boot up your MemberNet TV Ultra will launch and begin playing the playlist assigned to the unit.

Internet Setup

For maximum performance, Ethernet is recommended. The Ethernet on MemberNet TV supports 10/100/1000 Mbps. If you are using 4K Content this is the best option. These files can be 4X the size of 1080p content

Once Ethernet is connected, MemberNet TV will disable Wi-Fi and switch to Ethernet.

• For networks which don't support DHCP, the IP-related settings can be configured in Settings > Network Settings> "Ethernet." The next page shows screen shots for setup.

• For the best Wi-Fi experience, a 5 GHz dual-band 802.11 AC/N MIMO router is recommended. These routers are capable of operating in the 5 GHz band to prevent interference due to 802.11 wlan/non-wlan wireless radio sources that operate in the 2.4 GHz band.

 When setting up your Wi-Fi, it is recommended to scan the wireless environment and choose a less "congested" channel for the AP on either band. Configure the AP in "Auto" mode and "Auto" channel width (This field has different names depending on the AP vendor. Some call it "up to speeds" or "supported speeds."

Internet Setup

- 1. Using the remote select the back button, which will take you to the MemberNet TV Main Menu.
- 2. Navigate to the System Settings/Network Setup

- 4. If using a Wifi connection make sure that under Wireless Networks that the Active is toggled to the right.
- 5. If using a Wired Connection make sure that under Wired Networks that the Active is toggled to the right.

Ethernet Static IP

1. If DHCP is selected this option will pull a dynamic IP address from your network router. Common dynamic IP addresses begin with 192.168 or 10.1. This is the most common Ethernet Setup.

2. Select Static if your Store Network requires unique IP addresses for each device connected to the internet.

3. Enter your Static IP address. This is for advanced IT Professionals and the Static IP address is assigned from ISP (Internet Service Provider) such as Comcast, AT&T, Cox, Charter, Megapath, or any other internet provider.

User Interface Start up

1. Upon the first launch of the MemberNet TV Ultra HD it will need to check in and verify the content from your account in MemberNet (<u>www.nationwidemember.com</u>) and the MemberNet TV Player. This can take up to 3 minutes depending on your internet connection speed and the amount of content in the playlist.




2. Once completed it will begin playing the content playlist that has been programed to the player.



• To access the MemberNet TV Home Screen while the player is playing content select the back Button which is button on the remote.




• This will give you access to On-Demand and System Settings which will be covered on the next page.




• Use the D-Pad button to navigate the categories and video clips in each category and press the Select button to play the clip.

• When finished showing a demo Clip in On-Demand you have 2 options "Return to Playlist" which will begin playing your programed playlist or "Return to Main Menu" which will take you back to the MemberNet TV Ultra Home Screen.




• Use the D-Pad button to navigate and press the Select button to access either one of these options.

• System Settings allows you to force a Media Content Update, run a Network Test, Change the User Interface from Horizontal to Vertical, view the About information on the unit, and Authorize the application

• Media Content Update allows your MemberNet TV Ultra to check in right away to download any new playlist adjustments or updated content. Your MemberNet TV will automatically check in every night for new content or playlist updates this is only recommended if you have fast internet and only need a few clips to download.




• If you select Media Content Update during business hours it may slow down your internet speed.

• About shows information that pertains to this device such as Machine Name, Serial Number, Software Version, IP Address, Ethernet Mac Address, Wireless MAC address, Available Free Hard drive space, and System Uptime.




Tech support may ask you to visit this option to trouble shoot an issue.

User Interface System Settings

• Network Test allows you to make sure MemberNet TV reaches the web. This option pings both google.com and nationwidemember.com.



• Tech support may ask you to run a network test to make sure there are no firewalls in place to prevent the MemberNet TV from checking in and receiving content updates.

User Interface System Settings

• Vertical or Horizontal configures the UI (User Interface) for both Vertical and Horizontal.



• Depending on your playlist you can switch back and forth between vertical and horizontal. If you ordered your MNTV to be set up vertical this option will be selected for you when you select the MemberNet TV Ultra on the Home Screen.
